Eligibility Checklist & Application Instructions: Chemical & Biological Engineering Checklist for Eligibility

Student must be admitted to the BSCHE degree program (not in Pre-Chemical Engineering status).
One or more of the following BSCHE degree requirements must still need to be completed: CBE 486: Introduction to Statistics and Design of Experiments, Technical Elective, or Technical Elective-Engineering.
Student must be currently taking or have already successfully completed CBE 311: Introduction to Transport Phenomena with a "C-" or better.
Student must have a minimum degree GPA of a 3.0 after the semester in which their passing grades of "C-" or higher for CBE 253: Chemical Process Calculations II and CBE 302: Chemical Engineering Thermodynamics have posted (4th semester in the program, end of sophomore year/2nd year in the program.
